Annual Report 2022



2022 marked a turning point in Gifted Resource Council's post-pandemic era. While not all programming rebounded to 2019 levels, most notably Academic Challenge Cup, summer enrollment totals were robust. In fact, summer enrollment was the second highest in GRC's almost 40-year history—second only to 1997!

Academic Challenge Cup, which takes place early in the year, was limited by many of the Covid restrictions schools still had in place. These included limits on field trips and buses. Plus, a number of long-time ACC coaches had retired with no replacements to take on ACC duties.

However, by spring, many parents were eager for their children to have a “normal” summer, and registered in large numbers for camp.

Also in 2022, GRC's Board of Directors undertook the task of updating the organization's Strategic Plan, ultimately settling on three main initiatives to focus efforts on:

- Increasing GRC's visibility in the community through programming; resources for parents, schools and teachers; and providing more opportunity for family involvement.
- Increasing GRC's stewardship and management through diversifying funding streams.
- Advancing diversity, equity and inclusivity issues, including through staff and board development, review of curricula, and increased access for under-represented populations.



Gifted Resource Council is grateful for all the donors and friends who supported the organization through the pandemic, and ultimately, helped us come out even stronger on the other side.
