





2023 was a banner year in the history of Gifted Resource Council, marking 40 years since the founding of the organization! A party was held to honor all teachers who had worked with the organization for at least 20 years. Twelve teachers were recognized at the party and the silent auction brought in around \$6,000 with some wonderful items and activities up for grabs.

Academic Challenge Cup finally began to rebound from the pandemic era, increasing from 68 teams in 2022 to 140 teams in 2023.

Summer Academies registration reached a near record high with 406 enrollments and three new camps added to the line-up of old favorites: Animal Academy, Novel Engineering, and Stop Motion Animation. All new camps filled quickly when registration opened, letting us know that new offerings would be welcomed by the community.

Learning Labs had a combined enrollment of 287 - nowhere near pre-pandemic numbers, but slowly creeping back up.

Gifted Resource Council is grateful for all the donors and friends who supported the organization through the pandemic, and ultimately, helped us come out even stronger on the other side.





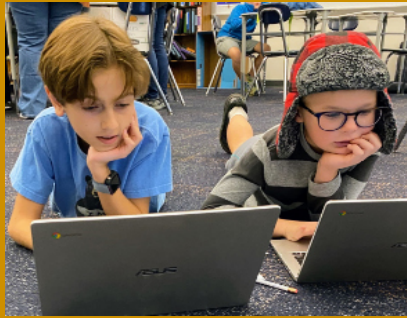
